

JULY 24, 2022 7TH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST



We all resemble two blind men from today's Gospel reading.

We resemble these ailing people, who were tormented by their infirmities, in both our spiritual and bodily infirmities, which torment us as did theirs; and in that, like them, we continue to ask for things from the Lord: for the alleviation of suffering, for our healing, for the return of our health and the joy of life, which we have somehow lost. But we do not always resemble them in their faith in the Lord and in His power. We do not resemble them in their fidelity to God, which is not as strong and undoubting as that of these two blind men. Is that not why we remain unhealed?

Let us not despair and lose heart in the darkness of sin. Let us not imagine that darkness, sin, and evil – and the grief that accompanies them – are our inescapable destiny. No! God resists the proud but gives grace to the humble. Let us endeavor to possess humility, and then God's power will certainly raise us from the lowest depressions of our sinful fallenness.

Kontakion, T.3: Today your all-glorious memory has shone forth,* O noble passion- bearers of Christ, Borys and Hlib,* summoning us to gather for the praise of Christ our God.* Wherefore, we who hasten to your relics,* receive the gift of healing by your prayers, O saints, for you are godly physicians.

Prokeimenon, T.6 Save Your people, O Lord, * and bless Your inheritance. *verse*: Unto You I will cry, O Lord, my God, lest You turn from me in silence.

Brothers and Sisters, we who are strong ought to put up with the failings of the weak, and not to please ourselves. Each of us must please our neighbour for the good purpose of building up the neighbour. For Christ did not please himself; but, as it is written, "The insults of those who insult you have fallen on me." For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, so that by steadfastness and by the encouragement of the scriptures we might have hope. May the God of steadfastness and encouragement grant you to live in harmony with one another, in accordance with Christ Jesus, so that together you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Welcome one another, therefore, just as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God.

OUR SAINTS



On July 24th Our Ukrainian Catholic Church commemorates two princes of the ancient Kyivan state who were among the first to be canonized saints. They were the youngest sons of St. Volodymyr the Great.

Following the death of their father, St. Volodymyr the Great, many of the brother-princes engaged in a battle for the acquisition of land and title. Unlike the other brothers, they chose not to fight and kill the other. They chose rather to peacefully accept death, martyrdom from their own brother-prince. They accepted death with calmness and a determination to

follow the ways of Christ, their Lord and Master.

Following their death circa 1015, the veneration of the princely martyrs Borys and Hlib quickly grew and spread throughout the ancient Kyivan state. The people recognized their courage, fortitude, to remain steadfast in the faith. Already in the year 1072 both Borys and Hlib were officially canonized, recognized as saints of our Church. This veneration continues to this very day in both the Ukrainian Catholic and Ukrainian Orthodox Churches.

Many Ukrainian Catholic and Orthodox men have one of them as their patron saint. Archbishop-Metropolitan Borys Gudziak of Philadelphia was named after the saintly martyred prince

O praiseworthy Martyrs of Christ,* you considered attacks by persecutors and violent death to be as nothing.* Boldly you armed yourselves with courage for battle,* and robed yourselves in glorious victory.* You were numbered with all the Just* with whom we bless you in constant praise.
