

JULY 31, 2022 8TH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST



In today's Gospel we see literally a multitude that have come to Jesus aware of their condition, wanting to be healed physically and spiritually, and aware of who He is – able to experience His healing love. They came to him from the cities, walking through the day to this deserted place, bearing their crippled, diseased and possession.

There are no Scribes and Pharisees here – they are not willing to make the sacrifice of this hard journey to see someone they have chosen not to believe. But this multitude loves Jesus. And they were not only loved by Him, but their faith warmed the and enflamed hearts compassion of the Disciples as well. And this heart, this love for those who come to Christ as this multitude has come, is the Disciples real calling and ministry. ... The Disciples are not, and those who will follow them are not, ministers of a religion, a movement or a teaching; they are ministers of the love of God – the source of healing - the only true source of healing.

Love is the food people in the desert need. The food we all need. This is what Jesus commands the Disciples to give to the multitude when he says to them, "you feed them." ... to love them as He loves them. **Troparion, T.7:** By Your cross You destroyed death;* You opened Paradise to the thief;* You changed the lamentation of the myrrh-bearers to joy,* and charged the apostles to proclaim* that You are risen, O Christ our God,* offering great mercy to the world.

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, T.7: No longer shall the dominion of death be able to hold humanity,* for Christ went down shattering and destroying it s powers.* Hades is bound.* The prophets exult with one voice.* The Saviour has come for those with faith, saying:* "Come forth, O faithful, to the resurrection!"

Now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Theotokion, T.7: O all-praised treasury of our resurrection, we hope in you,* bring us up from the pit and depth of sin,* for you have saved those subject to sin* by giving birth to our Salvation,* O Virgin before childbirth, and Virgin in childbirth,* and still a Virgin after childbirth.

Prokeimenon, T.7: The Lord will give strength to His people;* the Lord will bless His people with peace.

verse: Bring to the Lord, O you sons of God; bring to the Lord young rams.

A READING FROM THE FIRST LETTER OF SAINT PAUL TO THE CORINTHINS (1:10-18): Brothers and Sisters, I appeal to you by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same judgment. For it has been reported to me by Chloe's people that there is quarreling among you, my brothers. What I mean is that each one of you says, "I follow Paul," or "I follow Apollos," or "I follow Cephas," or "I follow Christ." Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul? I thank God that I baptized none of you except Crispus and Gaius, so that no one may say that you were baptized in my name. (I did baptize also the household of Stephanas. Beyond that, I do not know whether I baptized anyone else.) For Christ did not send me to baptize but to preach the gospel, and not with words of eloquent wisdom, lest the cross of Christ be emptied of its power.

This is an early Christian tradition. The first week of August, on the sixth of August, the farmers used to gather the first fruits of their summer harvest (grapes, figs, etc.) and to offer thanks to God and offer them to the Church to be blessed and then to give them to the faithful present at the Divine Liturgy as a blessing to them.

POPE FRANCIS 'APOLOGY THIS IS A PART OF THE APOLOGY TEXT DELIVERED ON JULY 25, 2022 "Today I am here, in this land that, along with its ancient memories, preserves the scars of still open wounds. I am here because the first step of my penitential pilgrimage

among you is that of again asking forgiveness, of telling you once more that I am deeply sorry.

Sorry for the ways in which, regrettably, many Christians supported the colonizing mentality of the powers that oppressed the Indigenous peoples. I am sorry. I ask forgiveness, in particular, for the ways in which many members of the Church and of religious communities co-operated, not least through their indifference, in projects of cultural destruction and forced assimilation promoted by the governments of that time, which culminated in the system of residential schools...

On this first step of my journey, I have wanted to make space for memory. Here, today, I am with you to recall the past, to grieve with you, to bow our heads together in silence and to pray before the graves. Let us allow these moments of silence to help us interiorize our pain. Silence. And prayer. In the face of evil, we pray to the Lord of goodness; in the face of death, we pray to the God of life. Our Lord Jesus Christ took a grave, which seemed the burial place of every hope and dream, leaving behind only sorrow, pain and resignation, and made it a place of rebirth and resurrection, the beginning of a history of new life and universal reconciliation.

Our own efforts are not enough to achieve healing and reconciliation: we need God's grace. We need the quiet and powerful wisdom of the Spirit, the tender love of the Comforter. May He bring to fulfilment the deepest expectations of our hearts. May He guide our steps and enable us to advance together on our journey". POPE FRANCIS.
