In the Parable of the Sower, we often see Jesus as the Sower of the seed and our souls as the various soils. Indeed, at any given moment, our souls can be fertile, rocky or thorny. We, therefore, always need to cooperate with the Holy Spirit so to be receptive to God's Word in our life.

Yet, when explaining the parable, Jesus does not say he is the Sower. What if we are the sowers of the seed? After all, has God not called us to work in His vineyard? Well, then, we better get sowing!

Notice how the sower in this parable sows the seed liberally? He does not test the soil first. He just goes about sowing the seed wherever he goes.

We must be like that sower, going around sharing the Gospel with all those around us – family, friends, coworkers, the grocery store clerk. Our concern is not whether their hearts are ready to receive the message. The Holy Spirit prepares the soil; we are only to sow the seed.

Our world today is in desperate need of Good News. You are the bearer of that Good News. Share it! *Troparion, T.4:* When the disciples of the Lord learned from the angel^{*} the glorious news of the resurrection^{*} and cast off the ancestral condemnation,^{*} they proudly told the apostles:^{*} "Death has been plundered!^{*} Christ our God is risen,^{*} granting to the world great mercy."

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, T.4: My Saviour and Deliverer from the grave* as God raised out of bondage the children of the earth* and shattered the gates of Hades;* and as Master, He rose on the third day.

Now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Theotokion, T.4: By your birth, O immaculate one,* Joachim and Anna were freed from the reproach of childlessness,* and Adam and Eve* from the corruption of death.* And your people, redeemed from the guilt of their sins,* celebrate as they cry out to you:* "The barren one gives birth to the Mother of God* and nourisher of our life."

Prokeimenon, T.4: How great are Your works, O Lord* You have made all things in wisdom.

verse: Bless the Lord, O my soul: O Lord my God, You are exceedingly great.

Epistle (Galatians 2:16-20): Brothers and Sisters, we know that a person is justified not by the works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ. And we have come to believe in Christ Jesus, so that we might be justified by faith in Christ, and not by doing the works of the law, because no one will be justified by the works of the law. But if, in our effort to be justified in Christ, we ourselves have been found to be sinners, is Christ then a servant of sin? Certainly not! But if I build up again the very things that I once tore down, then I demonstrate that I am a transgressor. For through the law I died to the law, so that I might live to God. I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

• UKRAINIAN CATHOLIC BISHOPS ISSUE CALL TO END UKRAINE WAR. The Ukrainian Catholic Bishops in Canada have issued a Pastoral Letter calling for continued Prayer, Fasting and Action (English, Ukrainian, and French) to end the tragic War in Ukraine.

The letter is issued in view of the annual commemoration on the last Saturday of November of the Holodomor – Genocide, the man-made famine in Ukraine that claimed millions of lives during 1932-1933.

Addressed to the faithful in Canada and to all people of good will, the bishops urge a response of faith to the evil of war, violence and death.

THE SIXTH WORLD DAY OF THE POOR will be marked on **November**



13th. Pope Francis message for the occasion focuses on the theme of: *For your sakes Christ became poor* (see 2 Corinthians 8:9).

"...There is a paradox that today, as in the past, we find hard to accept, for it clashes with our human way of thinking: that there exists a form of poverty that can make us rich. By appealing to the "grace" of Jesus Christ, Paul

wants to confirm the message that he himself preached. It is the message that true wealth does not consist in storing up "treasures on earth, where moth and rust consume, and where thieves break in and steal" (Mt 6:19), but rather in a reciprocal love that leads us to bear one another's burdens in such a way that no one is left behind or excluded. The sense of weakness and limitation that we have experienced in these recent years, and now the tragedy of the war with its global repercussions, must teach us one crucial thing: we are not in this world merely to survive, but to live a dignified and happy life. The message of Jesus shows us the way and makes us realize that there is a poverty that humiliates and kills, and another poverty, Christ's own poverty, that sets us free and brings us peace..."
