
PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

NOVEMBER 6, 2022 22 SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOS



As we say in the prayers of the Church, we will all need mercy before the judgment seat of Christ. We err, however, if we think of the Lord's mercy as being available only in some arbitrary way at some point in eternity. For we encounter Him every day in our neighbors, especially the poor, wretched, and inconvenient: the widow, the orphan, and the stranger. We participate in His mercy by showing mercy to them.

The rich man in today's parable shaped himself decisively in unholy ways by his behavior; in contrast, we may shape ourselves decisively in holy ways by our behavior. We never earn God's mercy, but we will ultimately make offerings of our lives to God or to something else. We will either worship and serve Him or ourselves. Perhaps the Lord's eternal judgment will be more a confirmation of who we have become than a shocking decree from out of the blue.

Troparion, T.5: Let us the faithful acclaim and worship the Word,* coeternal with the Father and the Spirit,* and born of the Virgin for our salvation.* For He willed to be lifted up on the cross in the flesh, to suffer death* and to raise the dead by His glorious resurrection.

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, T.5: You, my Saviour, descended to Hades,* and as the Almighty, You shattered its gates.* With Yourself You, as the Creator, raised the dead and shattered the sting of death,* and delivered Adam from the curse, O Lover of Mankind.* And so we cry out: "Save us, O Lord."

Now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Theotokion, T.5: Rejoice, O impassable door of the Lord!* Rejoice, O rampart and protection of those who have recourse to you!* Rejoice, O tranquil haven and Virgin,* who gave birth in the flesh to your Maker and God!* Fail not to intercede for those* who sing and worship the Child you bore.

Prokeimenon, T. 5: You, O Lord, will guard us and will keep us* from this generation and for ever.

verse: Save me, O Lord, for there is no longer left a just man.

A reading from the Epistle of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Galatians: Brothers and Sisters, see what large letters I make when I am writing in my own hand! It is those who want to make a good showing in the flesh that try to compel you to be circumcised—only that they may not be persecuted for the cross of Christ. Even the circumcised do not themselves obey the law, but they want you to be circumcised so that they may boast about your flesh. May I never boast of anything except the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. For neither circumcision nor uncircumcision is anything; but a new creation is everything! As for those who will follow this rule—peace be upon them, and mercy, and upon the Israel of God. From now on, let no one make trouble for me; for I carry the marks of Jesus branded on my body. May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brothers and sisters. Amen.

◆ UKRAINIAN CATHOLIC BISHOPS ISSUE CALL TO END UKRAINE WAR. The Ukrainian Catholic Bishops in Canada have issued a Pastoral Letter calling for continued Prayer, Fasting and Action (English, Ukrainian, and French) to end the tragic War in Ukraine.

The letter is issued in view of the annual commemoration on the last Saturday of November of the Holodomor – Genocide, the man-made famine in Ukraine that claimed millions of lives during 1932-1933.

Addressed to the faithful in Canada and to all people of good will, the bishops urge a response of faith to the evil of war, violence and death.

♦ THE SIXTH WORLD DAY OF THE POOR will be marked on November



- **13th**. Pope Francis message for the occasion focuses on the theme of: *For your sakes Christ became poor* (see 2 Corinthians 8:9).
- "...There is a paradox that today, as in the past, we find hard to accept, for it clashes with our human way of thinking: that there exists a form of poverty that can make us rich. By appealing to the "grace" of Jesus Christ, Paul wants to confirm the message that he

himself preached. It is the message that true wealth does not consist in storing up "treasures on earth, where moth and rust consume, and where thieves break in and steal" (Mt 6:19), but rather in a reciprocal love that leads us to bear one another's burdens in such a way that no one is left behind or excluded. The sense of weakness and limitation that we have experienced in these recent years, and now the tragedy of the war with its global repercussions, must teach us one crucial thing: we are not in this world merely to survive, but to live a dignified and happy life. The message of Jesus shows us the way and makes us realize that there is a poverty that humiliates and kills, and another poverty, Christ's own poverty, that sets us free and brings us peace..."
