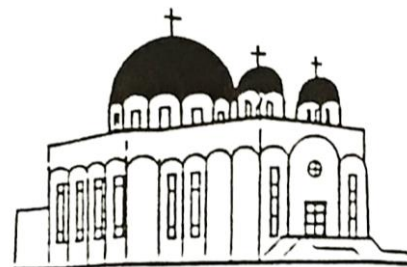

“Why do you fear the Devil, O Christians? He cannot force you to do anything. The Devil should, rather, fear you, not you the Devil, for you are clad in the armor and panoply of God; you have as a sling the sign of the Precious Cross, with which, and from a distance, you can smite all of the demons; you wield, as a two-edged sword, the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ, which the demons fear and at which they tremble.

As for you, if you are willing to keep the commandments of the Lord, and to be the true friends and soldiers of the Heavenly King, you will have no need of magic or any other device of the Devil, and you will trample on him with your feet as though he were a beast, a little sparrow, a scorpion, or an ant. ‘Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.’ [Lk 10:19]

◆ **UKRAINIAN CATHOLIC BISHOPS ISSUE CALL TO END UKRAINE WAR.** The Ukrainian Catholic Bishops in Canada have issued a Pastoral Letter calling for continued Prayer, Fasting and Action (English, Ukrainian, and French) to end the tragic War in Ukraine.

The letter is issued in view of the annual commemoration on the last Saturday of November of the Holodomor – Genocide, the man-made famine in Ukraine that claimed millions of lives during 1932-1933.

Addressed to the faithful in Canada and to all people of good will, the bishops urge a response of faith to the evil of war, violence and death.

◆ **THE SIXTH WORLD DAY OF THE POOR** will be marked on **November 13th**. Pope Francis message for the occasion focuses on the theme of: *For your sakes Christ became poor* (see 2 Corinthians 8:9).

◆ **INVITATION** The 7th Miracle Theatre of Prince George production, **Dancing Lessons**. Dancing Lessons will open **on March 30, 2023** and run until April 19 at the Knox Performance Space – it is a delightful comedy about a unique romantic couple. #### OUR LITURGICAL YEAR

Our father among the saints **John Chrysostom** (347-407), Archbishop of Constantinople, was a notable Christian bishop and preacher from the 4th and 5th centuries in Syria and Constantinople. He is famous for his eloquence in public speaking, his philanthropy, his denunciation of abuse of authority in the Church and in the Roman Empire of the time, and for a Divine Liturgy attributed to him. He had notable ascetic sensibilities. After his death he was named **Chrysostom**, which comes from the Greek "golden-mouthed." The Eastern Church counts him among the Three Holy Hierarchs, together with Saints Basil the Great and Gregory the

Theologian. Another feast day associated with him is January 27, which commemorates the event in 437, thirty years after the saint's repose, when his relics were brought back to Constantinople.

John Chrysostom is also recognized by the Roman Catholic Church, which considers him a saint and Doctor of the Church. His relics were stolen from Constantinople by crusaders in 1204 and brought to Rome, but were returned on November 27, 2004, by Pope John Paul II.

In little more than a year, a quarter of the population perished.  
This crime of genocide is known as the Holodomor.*
