What is the most common command in Scripture? It is not to be more loving, even though that may be the core of God's desire for human. It is not about pride, even though that is the root of mankind's fallenness. The single command in Scripture that appears more than any other (God's most frequent instruction) is: Fear Not!

There are 366 'fear not' verses in the Bible. That is one for every day of the year, including one for leap year! Now, fear does not seem like the most serious vice in the world. It has never made the list of the Seven Deadly Sins. So why does God tell human beings to stop being afraid more often than He tells them anything else?

It is because fear is the number one reason humans lose their faith and commitment to God, and then stop doing what He wants them to do with their lives. It was fear that caused the Israelites to murmur and rebel in the wilderness. It was fear that caused eleven of the twelve spies who were sent to investigate the Promise Land to testify that they could not take the land. It was fear that caused Peter to deny the Lord, and fear that caused the very people Jesus came to save to cry out "Crucify Him, Crucify Him." Fear is serious business in the Spiritual World. Thus: Fear Not!

A READING FROM THE EPISTLE OF ST. PAUL TO THE CORINTHIANS 3:9-17:

*Brothers and Sisters,* for we are God's servants, working together; you are God's field, God's building. According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and someone else is building on it. Each builder must choose with care how to build on it. For no one can lay any foundation other than the one that has been laid; that foundation is Jesus Christ. Now if anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw — the work of each builder will become visible, for the Day will disclose it, because it will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each has done. If what has been built on the foundation survives, the builder will receive a reward. If the work is burned up, the builder will suffer loss; the builder will be saved, but only as through fire. Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you? If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy that person. For God's temple is holy, and you are that temple.



2) You have participated 8 in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently;

3) You attend Divine Services regularly;

4) Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church;

5) You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast).

6) You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel.

7) To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace.

If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are very welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing.

### **GOD IS IN CHARGE**
